As we collectively monitor the rapid evolving coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, Invicro's top priority is the safety and well-being of our employees, families, and study subjects. We want to assure you that we are taking every measurement and precaution to remain operational, to keep your projects running, and to support the research and clinical trial community.

Based on US guidelines, Invicro's work and business is evidently defined as essential. We are conducting research on serious diseases and some of the most innovative therapeutic drugs and regimes.
